HYDERABAD: Six people were killed as heavy rains lashed several parts of Telangana on Tuesday, throwing normal life out of gear. Six deaths were reported in separate rain-related incidents. Three persons including two women died of lightning in Jayashankar Bhupalapally district. Three others were drowned in Sangareddy and Wanaparthy districts.

Kerala youth commits suicide

KOCHI: A Kerala youth on Tuesday committed suicide in his house, an hour after stabbing a 19-year-old nursing student and her parents, said police. According to the police, around noon time, the youth identified as Eldhos, barged into the house of the young nursing student, Alkha. He stabbed her several times and hearing the cries, her parents Ouseph and Chinna came to her defence and they were also injured.

Father kills 14-month-old baby

RAICHUR: In a shocking case, a man killed his 14-month-old baby in Karnataka's Raichur district as he felt that the child would hamper his chances of remarriage, officials said on Tuesday. The man confessed to the police that he committed the crime. The accused was identified as 32-year-old Mahantesh, a resident of Kanavathi village in Lingasur taluk. The deceased child was known as Abhinava.

Mumbai reports second Zika case

MUMBAI: A second case of Zika virus has been found in Mumbai, the Brihanmumbai Municipal Corporation (BMC) said on Tuesday. The first case was reported on August 23. The second patient is a 15-year-old girl from suburban Kurla in eastern Mumbai which is under the jurisdiction of the civic body's L-ward, a BMC release said. The girl, who had other comorbidities, complained of fever and headache since August 20 and received treatment from a private hospital, the release said.

Go First cancels all flights

MUMBAI: Go First Airways cancelled all its flights scheduled till September 10 due to operational reasons, the airline said in a statement on Tuesday. "We regret to inform that due to operational reasons, Go First flights scheduled till 10th September 2023 have been cancelled. We apologise for the inconvenience caused by the flight cancellations," the statement read. Further, it said, "We acknowledge the flight cancellations might have disrupted your travel plans and we are committed to providing all the assistance we can."

The top court had on August 4 stayed his conviction in the defamation case. Gandhi represents Wayanad in the lower House of Parliament. The Congress leader was disqualified as an MP on March 24 after a Gujarat court convicted and sentenced him to two-year imprisonment for criminal defamation for comments he made about the Modi surname.

Umar Khalid's bail plea hearing adjourned

AGENCIES New Delhi
The Supreme Court on Tuesday adjourned hearing on bail plea filed by student activist Umar Khalid who was arrested and charged under the Unlawful Activities (Prevention) Act in connection with the alleged larger conspiracy case behind the 2020 Delhi riots. A bench comprising Justices Bela M. Trivedi and Dipankar Datta was apprised that a letter seeking adjournment has been circulated as senior advocate Kapil Sibal, who would argue on Khalid's behalf, is appearing before Chief Justice of India D.Y. Chandrachud-led Constitution Bench hearing pleas against abrogation of Article 370. At this, the bench remarked: "How many times? Mr. Sibal is bound to be busy. We cannot wait for any particular senior counsel." The top court clarified that it is granting the "last opportunity" and posted the plea for hearing in the coming week. On August 18, the hearing in the matter was deferred and the plea was directed to be listed after a period of two weeks. Also in August, Justice Prashant Kumar Mishra of the Supreme Court had recused himself from hearing the matter and the plea was directed to be listed before a different bench. "This will come before some other bench. There is some difficulty on part of my brother (Justice PK Mishra)," a bench headed by Justice A.S. Bopanna told the parties. Khalid has approached the top court against denial of bail by the Delhi High court.

Father kills 14-month-old baby

RAICHUR: In a shocking case, a man killed his 14-month-old baby in Karnataka's Raichur district as he felt that the child would hamper his chances of remarriage, officials said on Tuesday. The man confessed to the police that he committed the crime. The accused was identified as 32-year-old Mahantesh, a resident of Kanasaiv village in Lingasugur taluk. The deceased child was known as Abhinava.

Mumbai reports second Zika case

MUMBAI: A second case of Zika virus has been found in Mumbai, the Brihanmumbai Municipal Corporation (BMC) said on Tuesday. The first case was reported on August 23. The second patient is a 15-year-old girl from suburban Kuria in eastern Mumbai which is under the jurisdiction of the civic body's L-ward, a BMC release said.

Go First cancels all flights

MUMBAI: Go First Airways cancelled all its flights scheduled till September 10 due to operational reasons, the airline said in a statement on Tuesday. "We regret to inform that due to operational reasons, Go First flights scheduled till 10th September 2023 have been cancelled. We apologise for the inconvenience caused by the flight cancellations," the statement read. Further, it said, "We acknowledge the flight cancellations might have disrupted your travel plans and we are committed to providing all the assistance we can."

TOP COURT sets aside death penalty to man

NEW DELHI: A judge has to be fair and impartial but that does not mean he will simply shut his eyes and be a mute spectator acting like a robot, the Supreme Court has said while criticising the trial court and the Patna High Court which handed down death penalty to a man accused of raping and strangling to death an 11-year-old girl who had gone to watch television at his home in 2015. Setting aside the order of death sentence, the top court remitted the case back to the high court for reconsideration of the death reference after noting serious flaws in the investigation. The apex court was hearing an appeal filed by a man challenging the death penalty awarded to him for raping and strangling the girl.

allegedly gone to his home in a village in Bihar's Bhagalpur district to watch television. The trial court in Bhagalpur had in 2017 convicted the accused of rape and murder and handed down the death penalty, holding the offence fell under the rarest of rare category. The Patna High Court had in 2018 dismissed his appeal against conviction and confirmed the death penalty. An apex court bench of Justices B R Gavai, J B Pardiwala and Prashant Kumar Mishra said there were very serious lapses in the entire investigation and even the Forensic Science Laboratory report was not obtained. "The aforesaid lapse is just a tip of the iceberg. We are at pains to state that it is a very serious flaw on the part of the investigating officer and that too in such a serious matter," the bench said.



NEW DELHI: A group of 262 eminent citizens, including former high court judges and bureaucrats and war veterans have penned a letter to the Chief Justice of India requesting him to take suo moto cognizance of the alleged hate speech made by Tamil Nadu Minister Udhayanidhi Stalin, who is the son of Chief Minister M.K. Stalin, over his remarks on 'Sanatan Dharma'.

The letter stated that Stalin Jr.'s comments amount to hate speech against a large population of India and strikes at the very core of the Constitution of India which envisages Bharat as a secular nation. It said that the state government refused to take any action against Udhayanidhi Stalin and rather chose to justify his remarks. It stated that the



action of the TN government ran in the face of the judgment of the Supreme Court which had directed that state governments should take suo moto action against any hate speech crime without waiting for any complaint. "Since the State Government has refused to take action and acted in contempt of the Court's orders and gravely undermined or rather made a mockery of the rule of law, we urge the Hon'ble Supreme Court to take the suo moto notice of contempt, ensuring accountability for the inaction of the State Government of Tamil Nadu," the letter stated. Notably, the Supreme Court in the case of Shaheen Abdulla v. Union of India and Ors., observed that there cannot be fraternity unless different religious communities are amenable to live in harmony. The top court had expressed concern over the growing incidents of hate speeches in the country and had directed the governments and police authorities to take suo motu action in such cases without waiting for formal complaints.

Take suo moto cognizance of hate speech

It had said that any delay on the part of the administration in taking action on 'very serious issues' will invite the court's contempt as action is needed in order to preserve the secular character of the country. Udhayanidhi Stalin, had spoken at a function of Tamil Nadu Progressive Writers on eradication of Sanatan Dharma, saying that it was against social justice. He had also said that Sanatan Dharma must be eradicated like mosquitoes, dengue, and malaria.

I'm also Sanatani: Kejriwal

NEW DELHI: Delhi Chief Minister Arvind Kejriwal on Tuesday, while commenting on Tamil Nadu minister Udhayanidhi Stalin's remark on Sanatan Dharma that sparked a widespread controversy, said "we should respect other's religion". Udhayanidhi Stalin, the Tamil Nadu's Minister for Sports and Youth Affairs and son of Chief Minister M.K. Stalin, while speaking at an event on Saturday, said: "Sanatan Dharma has to be eradicated just like mosquitoes, malaria, dengue, and corona." Reacting to the remarks, the Delhi Chief Minister said: "I am also from Sanatan Dharma. There will be many from Sanatan Dharma. We should respect each other. Insulting other religions is not a good thing."

Umar Khalid's bail plea hearing adjourned

AGENCIES New Delhi The Supreme Court on Tuesday adjourned hearing on bail plea filed by student activist Umar Khalid who was arrested and charged under the Unlawful Activities (Prevention) Act in connection with the alleged larger conspiracy case behind the 2020 Delhi riots. A bench comprising Justices Bela M. Trivedi and Dipankar Datta was apprised that a letter seeking adjournment has been circulated as senior advocate Kapil Sibal, who would argue on Khalid's behalf, is appearing before Chief Justice of India D.Y. Chandrachud-led Constitution Bench hearing pleas against abrogation of Article 370. At this, the bench remarked: "How many times? Mr. Sibal is bound to be busy. We cannot wait for any particular senior counsel." The top court clarified that it is granting the "last opportunity" and posted the plea for hearing in the coming week. On August 18, the hearing in the matter was deferred and the plea was directed to be listed after a period of two weeks. Also in August, Justice Prashant Kumar Mishra of the Supreme Court had recused himself from hearing the matter and the plea was directed to be listed before a different bench. "This will come before some other bench. There is some difficulty on part of my brother (Justice PK Mishra)," a bench headed by Justice A.S. Bopanna told the parties. Khalid has approached the top court against denial of bail by the Delhi High court.

Cong gathers at Sonia's House, INDIA meet later

ONLINE REPORT New Delhi The buzz about the change of the country's name from "India" to "Bharat" has started a flurry of meetings in the Opposition camp. A meeting of Congress's parliamentary leaders is in progress at the house of Sonia Gandhi. It will be followed by a meet of opposition bloc INDIA leaders at the residence of party chief Mallikarjun Kharge. The buzz had exploded this morning with the news that the President Droupadi Murmu's invite to G20 leaders introduces her as the "President of Bharat" instead of the traditional "President of India".

The G20 booklet handed to foreign delegates has been titled "Bharat, The Mother Of Democracy". "Bharat is the official name of the country. It is mentioned in the Constitution as also in the discussions of 1946-48," it mentions.

NBW issued against Sasikala

BENGALURU: Karnataka Lokayukta special court on Tuesday issued non-bailable warrants against the Sasikala and Ilavarasi in connection with a bribery case during their imprisonment in central jail. The court has also issued warrants against the persons who have given sureties. It was alleged that Sasikala, former AIADMK general secretary, had given Rs 2 crore bribe to officers to avail special benefits inside the prison. It was also alleged that Sasikala and Ilavarasi had gone out for shopping from the jail. Lokayukta Police have submitted a charge sheet to the court in this connection. The Bengaluru Lokayukta court is looking into the case and Sasikala, Ilavarasi had not appeared before the court. The court had asked the Lokayukta officers to take custody of the accused and produce before the court. The matter has been adjourned to October 5. Sasikala and Ilavarasi were imprisoned for four years in the disproportionate assets case of former Tamil Nadu chief minister late Jayalalithaa.

BJP should know who they're dealing with: Gehlot

ONLINE REPORT / Jaipur Rajasthan Chief Minister Ashok Gehlot said the Centre's push for 'one nation, one election' without developing a consensus is an example of democracy being in danger in India. Gehlot was asked about his opinion on holding simultaneous elections for the Lok Sabha and state assemblies across the country. "I have been saying this for a long time. Whatever is happening today, no one knows the direction that the country is heading in. Democracy is in danger and the Constitution is being ripped to shreds. Simultaneous polls are an example of this. The Centre could have done this by taking opposition parties along and holding discussions with them," the chief minister said in Hindi. Referring to former President Ram Nath Kovind heading the committee to examine the issue, the Congress leader said, "The President's post is a prestigious one. I have never heard of a former President heading a committee.



Whatever is happening today, no one knows the direction that the country is heading in. Democracy is in danger and the Constitution is being ripped to shreds. The committee will be criticised as well as praised, and you have needlessly involved the former President in this." Gehlot said the Centre could have taken the opposition into confidence and the fact that it did not do so makes people doubt its intentions. He said the government was well within its rights to call the special Parliament session from September 18-22, but it has still not told the nation why it has been called. "These things are not good in a democracy," he said. The Chief Minister asserted that the people of Rajasthan have made up their minds to re-elect the Congress government in the state.

MARATHA QUOTA ROW Bandh disrupts life in Kolhapur

Maratha reservation returned to the centre stage last week after the police baton charged and lobbed tear gas shells to disperse a violent mob in Antarwali Sarathi village in Jalna district



KOLHAPUR: The bandh called by Maratha outfits in western Maharashtra's Kolhapur on Tuesday received a good response, as a majority of the commercial establishments remained shut in the city. Sakal Maratha Samaj led an agitation in Kolhapur's Dasara Chowk, condemning the violence against protesters in Jalna last week, and asked the government to clear their stand on the reservation for the Maratha community. Maratha reservation returned to the centre stage last week after the police baton-charged and lobbed tear gas shells to disperse a violent mob in Antarwali Sarathi village in Jalna district.
