The budget session of the Uttar Pradesh assembly, on Friday, opened to chants of 'Jai Shri Ram' as all legislators of BJP and its allied parties trooped wearing saffron scarves.

The NDA members thanked Prime Minister Narendra Modi and Chief Minister Yogi Adityanath for the grand Ram temple in Ayodhya.

Meanwhile, as soon as Governor Anandiben Patel started addressing the joint session of the state legislature, opposition members started shouting slogans against the government.

The Governor continued with her speech but nothing was audible in the din. The house was later adjourned for the day after obituary references.

The state cabinet was scheduled to visit the Ram temple on February 1, which was postponed by the government on account of heavy rush of devotees to the shrine. Opposition leaders have agreed to visit Ayodhya after the budget session of the state assembly ends on February 12. The session is scheduled to start on Friday with Governor Anandi Ben Patel's joint address to the both Houses of the Assembly. The state government is scheduled to table the budget on February 5.

SFIO BEGINS PROBE AGAINST VIJAYAN'S DAUGHTER

THIRUVANANTHAPURAM: Serious Fraud Investigation Office (SFIO) has begun to probe Kerala Chief Minister Pinarayi Vijayan daughter's IT firm on Friday. The Kerala Assembly also witnessed ruckus after the Congress led opposition and asked the Speaker to discuss the issue of the Chief Minister's daughter. However, the Speaker A.N. Shamsheer declined the opposition's request. "Two statutory agencies are now probing IT scam. What's to be noted is that the probe by SFIO is grave. It's high time that Vijayan quits," Leader of the Opposition V.D. Satheesan told media persons.

Delhi school vacated after bomb threat, nothing found

NEW DELHI: The Delhi Public School in RK Puram on Friday received a bomb threat via email following which the premises were immediately vacated and a search operation launched, police said.

Deputy Commissioner of Police (southwest) Rohit Meena said nothing suspicious was found during the search.

"With the help of school management, the fire brigade team, quick response teams and the police evacuated the school and launched a search operation. A prima facie investigation suggested that it seemed to be a hoax bomb threat. We have asked our cyber unit and other teams to track the IP address of the email," he said.

"The school and hostel have been thoroughly searched by the bomb

detection team (BDT) and dog squad but nothing was found suspicious by the teams. Further investigation into the matter is underway. No FIR has been registered so far," Meena told PTI.

Police said that the school received an email about two bombs on the premises around 9 am after which the administration immediately informed the police about the matter.

"More than 500 people, including students, vacated the building. We also asked the management to stay calm and arrange buses to send students and teachers back to their homes safely," Meena said, adding that the management announced an off for the day.

No immediate reaction was received from the school.

Bajrang Dal launches Hanuman Dhawj campaign in K'taka



BENGALURU: Bajrang Dal and Hindu organisations on Friday launched Hanuman Dhawj campaign across Karnataka while condemning the removal of Hanuman Dhawj in Keragodu village of Mandya district which has created controversy in the state.

Bajrang Dal said that the campaign will be carried out till February 9 and also gave a call to recite Hanuman Chalisa in front of all the offices of District Commissioners in the state.

K.R. Sunil, Bajrang Dal Karnataka South Province Coordinator

said that the incident of removal of Hanuman flag in Mandya district has hurt religious feelings of Hindus.

"In order to fill the spirit and confidence among the Hindu community the campaign has been launched. We request people to hoist Hanuman flag atop every house and every temple and Hindu religious centres in the state."

"On February 9, Hanuman Chalisa will also be recited before all the District Commissioners offices," he said.

He said that to primary demand is to urge the government to hoist the Hanuman flag in Keragodu village where it was taken down.

"In case the government refuses, the campaign will continue," he said.

Youth held for garlanding Tipu Sultan statue with slippers

RAICHUR: Karnataka police have arrested an accused in connection with the case of garlanding Tipu Sultan's statue with slippers in Raichur district, police said on Friday.

The accused is identified as 23-year-old Akash Talwar, a resident of Sirivara town in Manvitaluk. Police explain that following the incident, Nikhil B. had formed two special teams following the incident.

The police have also gathered CCTV footage in the region and took three persons into custody. The accused was one among them and confessed to the crime

after being grilled by the police.

The accused has been sent to judicial custody. Karnataka's Sirivara town was tense following the violation of the statue of the erstwhile ruler of Mysuru, Tipu Sultan on January 31.

A large number of people have come out in the open condemning the incident and are staging a protest at the Tipu Circle.

They had also blocked the road and torched tyres at the protest site, demanding immediate arrest of the people behind the vandalism. Sirivara police have registered a case in this regard.

Delhi school vacated after bomb threat, nothing found

NEW DELHI: The Delhi Public School in RK Puram on Friday received a bomb threat via email following which the premises were immediately vacated and a search operation launched, police said.

Deputy Commissioner of Police (southwest) Rohit Meena said nothing suspicious was found during the search.

"With the help of school management, the fire brigade team, quick response teams and the police evacuated the school and launched a search operation. A prima facie investigation suggested that it seemed to be a hoax bomb threat. We have asked our cyber unit and other teams to track the IP address of the email," he said.

"The school and hostel have been thoroughly searched by the bomb

detection team (BDT) and dog squad but nothing was found suspicious by the teams. Further investigation into the matter is underway. No FIR has been registered so far," Meena told PTI.

Police said that the school received an email about two bombs on the premises around 9 am after which the administration immediately informed the police about the matter.

"More than 500 people, including students, vacated the building. We also asked the management to stay calm and arrange buses to send students and teachers back to their homes safely," Meena said, adding that the management announced an off for the day.

No immediate reaction was received from the school.

Bajrang Dal launches Hanuman Dhawj campaign in K'taka



BENGALURU: Bajrang Dal and Hindu organisations on Friday launched Hanuman Dhawj campaign across Karnataka while condemning the removal of Hanuman Dhawj in Keragodu village of Mandya district which has created controversy in the state.

Bajrang Dal said that the campaign will be carried out till February 9 and also gave a call to recite Hanuman Chalisa in front of all the offices of District Commissioners in the state.

K.R. Sunil, Bajrang Dal Karnataka South Province Coordinator

said that the incident of removal of Hanuman flag in Mandya district has hurt religious feelings of Hindus.

"In order to fill the spirit and confidence among the Hindu community the campaign has been launched. We request people to hoist Hanuman flag atop every house and every temple and Hindu religious centres in the state."

"On February 9, Hanuman Chalisa will also be recited before all the District Commissioners offices," he said.

He said that to the primary demand is to urge the government to hoist the Hanuman flag in Keragodu village where it was taken down.

"In case the government refuses, the campaign will continue," he said.

Youth held for garlanding Tipu Sultan statue with slippers

RAICHUR: Karnataka police have arrested an accused in connection with the case of garlanding Tipu Sultan's statue with slippers in Raichur district, police said on Friday.

The accused is identified as 23-year-old Akash Talwar, a resident of Sirivara town in Manvitaluk. Police explain that following the incident, Nikhil B. had formed two special teams following the incident.

The police have also gathered CCTV footage in the region and took three persons into custody. The accused was one among them and confessed to the crime

after being grilled by the police.

The accused has been sent to judicial custody. Karnataka's Sirivara town was tense following the violation of the statue of the erstwhile ruler of Mysuru, Tipu Sultan on January 31.

A large number of people have come out in the open condemning the incident and are staging a protest at the Tipu Circle.

They had also blocked the road and torched tyres at the protest site, demanding immediate arrest of the people behind the vandalism. Sirivara police have registered a case in this regard.
